\*Located in main conference area.

**\*Bauer Lodge:** Bauer is a sixty-four room hotel. Rooms can accommodate up to four people with two queen beds or one queen and two single beds.

**\*Bauer Lodge Suites:** These suites have a sitting area with lounge chairs and a coffee table. Also includes a small refrigerator, sink, coffee maker and microwave. Suites have a queen sofa bed and two queen beds or one queen and a single.

**\*Kern Lodge:** A modern hotel with 57 guest rooms. Rooms can accommodate up to four people with two queen beds or one queen and two single beds.

**\*Roger Williams Inn:** A lakeside hotel with old time charm. Rooms can accommodate one to four persons. Queen beds and single beds available.




**\*Lawson Lodge:** Lawson Lodge has 10 mini suites with a queen bed, refrigerator, microwave and coffee maker.
