submit the following:**

- A. Official transcript of grades and evidence of sophomore, junior, senior or graduate standing. The official transcript must include the official school seal or watermark. A photocopy or scanned version of the official transcript electronically submitted is acceptable.
- B. A letter of support from two instructors that address the following:
 - 1. A statement of the experience the writer has had with the student
 - 2. Leadership ability of the student
 - 3. Activities the student has participated in relating to the teaching of their intended major
 - 4. View of student's potential success as a teacher and a role model for a diverse student population
- C. A list of any community-based or school-based activities involving children, honors received, and professional organization memberships that demonstrate an interest in mathematics education
- D. An essay (no longer than two pages total) addressing all the ideas below:
 - 1. A current Diversity/Equity/Access/Inclusion issue in mathematics education in which you are especially interested
 - 2. The importance to you upon graduation to teach in a school setting that reflects your race/ethnicity; please elaborate
 - 3. How your life experiences have impacted your decision to go into the field of education

The completed applications and supporting documents, including transcripts and letters of support, should be submitted to wmef@wismath.org. All documents must be clearly identified with the applicant's name. Please also put the applicant's name in the subject line.

(all submissions must be word-processed, double spaced, using 12 point Arial or similar font and one-inch margins)

The candidates will be selected using the following criteria:

- Academic record and teacher letters of support: 40%
- Essay Response: 60%

The decision of the Selection Committee is final.
