



Eligibility Criteria for WMEF College Scholarships

The **Wisconsin Mathematics Education Foundation** currently offers a \$2,000 scholarship to qualified students currently enrolled in teacher education programs in the state of Wisconsin. To be eligible students must

- be a resident of Wisconsin
- currently be enrolled in a Wisconsin public or private teacher education program
- enrolled in a teacher preparation course of study and be enrolled in or have completed a course incorporating the teaching of mathematics
- currently have a GPA of at least 3.00 (B average) or better.

If the applicant is a *secondary* major, the applicant must have successfully completed 16 credits in mathematics. Statistics and computer science courses may count towards these 16 credits.

If the applicant is an *elementary* major, he/she must have successfully completed 6 credits of mathematics. Statistics and computer science courses may count towards these 6 credits.
